

## GROUP DUTIES

Where the majority of the camp are children we insist that at least one adult is included with each group setting and clearing tables.

**SETTING AND CLEARING TABLES** - 4 people required each meal (including 1 adult).

### Before each meal

- Report to the kitchen 15 minutes prior to each meal.
- Set tables as directed by camp staff.

### After each meal.

- Return butter trays, jugs, toast racks, spreads etc to servery.
- Wipe down and sanitize tables.
- Sweep or mop floors if necessary

**CAMPERS DISHES** - 2 adults required after each meal.

***(Children are not permitted in our wash-up area)***

### After each meal.

- Report to the camp wash-up kitchen.
- Wash the campers dishes using the dishwasher.

### **BAKING.**

All meals are prepared and cooked by our camp Chefs. HHCC has a reputation for providing excellent meals. Camp fees include breakfast, lunch and dinner. Drinks (tea, coffee, cordial and sugar) are provided for morning tea and supper. For school camps and children's camps hot Milo is provided for breakfast and supper. We also provide all crockery and cutlery required.

Groups are required to bring their own biscuits and cakes for morning tea, afternoon tea and supper.

### **END OF CAMP CLEAN UP.**

The camp organizer will undertake that prior to vacating HHCC, he/she will ensure that all buildings, equipment and facilities are cleaned and restored to the same standard they were on arrival.

Any damage/uncleaned areas found may mean a reduction in the amount of your deposit refunded.
