

Parent / Guardian Notes

A completed registration form is required along with full payment to register your child.

Please provide any spending money in coins for the vending machine.

Do not drop your child off before the starting time, as no supervision is available.

HHCC does not provide transport to and from camp, please arrange for your child to be dropped off and picked up at the times specified.

Parent/guardians must sign their child in and out of camp. Please do not leave or pick up your child without doing this.

Disruptive behavior, deliberate misconduct or disrespect for camp or campers property will result in the person concerned being sent home. Fees will not be refunded and any costs for damage or transport will be charged.

All medication is to be handed in at the start of camp. It will be administered as required by a camp adult.

As part of our "Sun Safe" policy your child will be required to wear a hat in the sun. If they don't have a suitable hat they will not be permitted to participate in outdoor programmes.

If your child has any special needs please contact camp before sending in your registration form.

Kids Camps are conducted by residential staff of Highland Home Christian Camp and assisted by a team of volunteer programme managers, leaders and helpers.

Bible based talks are conducted on a non sectarian-basis, the purpose being to show the relevance of the bible today.

Your child could be involved in one or more of the following activities: abseiling, caving, tramping, swimming, rock climbing, low ropes confidence course, rifle shooting, organised visits to attractions within the Manawatu and Wairarapa.

The information you provide will only be used for the purposes of running the camp. Personal details will remain confidential to camp management and will only be given out to ensure the safety or well-being of a camper.

Camp management asks that you don't visit or phone your child during camp as it can be disruptive to the programme and unsettling to your child and others. If, in an emergency, you need to contact your child you can do so by phoning 06 3294716 and following the prompts.

We will contact you if your child is unwell or not coping with being away from home.

Camper's Notes.

To have lots of fun:

Attend all activities and listen to the directions given by the programme managers and leaders.

No bullying or being mean to others, if you do you could be sent home.

Please don't bring any electronic toys or cell-phones to camp. We don't have cell-phone coverage anyway!

Don't bring any food, sweets or peanut products.

Need Funding?

We are OSCAR (Out of School Care and Recreation) accredited. You can get funding assistance for Kids Camp. Please contact your local WINZ office to see if you qualify for an OSCAR subsidy. We will fill out our part of the form and get it back to you for submission. The earlier this can be done the better. **However full payment is required with your child's registration.**

When HHCC receives payment from WINZ Office we will reimburse you. In some cases this may take several weeks.

Some sponsorship may also be available. Please apply in writing to Highland Home Christian Camp.

Things to Bring

Daypack - Drink – bottle - Sleeping Bag – Under sheet - Pillow Pyjamas - Toiletries (*include sunscreen*) - 2 Towels - Togs - 6x changes of clothes - Warm jersey or bushshirt – Hat - Raincoat - Rubbish bag for wet gear – Sneakers - Strong shoes for tramping - Torch (*essential*) - Cycle helmet (*essential*) –

\$1.00 or \$2.00 coins for drink vending machine.
